

Data Rollup Vendor Update, Feb 2017

Data Basics

- IF school is rolling data up - the report card/transcript data is in Data Rollup.
- When migrating to a new SIS, schools export student and staff demographic data from the old SIS and then import that data to the new SIS.
- Grades and attendance *should* be in Data Rollup for the records.
- Key to accurate output is that the data needs to be accurate in Data Rollup. **The key to accuracy is good setup and compliance with NAD protocols.**

Chalkable Private School (CPS)

- Chalkable was bought out by PowerSchool (PS) October 2016
- PS will continue to support CPS for the SDA product for an undefined period of time.
- PS plans to do an “end of life” for CPS at some point - guaranteed through 2020 school year.
- CPS will remain an approved vendor for those already using CPS until PowerSchool stops supporting Data Rollup.
- **NAD is NOT recommending to move to CPS as a new SIS product for 2017-18 and forward.**
- A special training session (run by CPS) is being scheduled this summer (via webinar) for conference level users for setting up schools for 2017-18 school year.

Jupiter

- Built in Learning Management System, Gradebook, Learning Analytics SIS for K-12
- Student base of 3.7 million students over last 12 years
- Fully integrated for both Mac and PC
- \$6.00/student - no startup fees, no support costs, no minimum numbers
- Intuitive for the small school
- Training for 2017-18 School Year
 - Custom video training demonstrating setting up and using Jupiter for Adventist schools (Paid for by NAD)
 - Live on-line question and answer sessions with Jupiter trainers for schools to answer questions about setup and Data Rollup reporting, etc. (Paid for by NAD)
 - One online training seminar for conference level users to be conducted by Jupiter's trainer (Paid for by NAD)

RenWeb

- RenWeb was bought out by FACTS October 2014
 - FACTS is not a competitor to Renweb, but a complementing suite of programs designed around tuition management.
- RenWeb1 will be more Mac friendly when it is complete.
- New Learning Management System (LMS) is being piloted this year
- Working on improving support
 - VP of Operations & Director of Professional Services are now involved
 - Weekly calls with Martha Ban scheduled to review open tickets
 - Will provide documentation so all schools can follow the same setup
 - Troubleshooting help for Data Rollup errors

 - SDA sessions specifically for Conferences (how to set schools up for stress-free Data Rollup experience)
- Great pricing structure that can be very helpful to small schools. 80/100 rule: if 80% of the large schools in a conference purchases/uses RenWeb then 100% of the small schools (49 and less) in the conference can have the BASIC package for free.
